INSPIRING GROWTH, NEW SKILLS, AND INNOVATION FOR TRANSITIONAL-AGE EMPOWERMENT (IGNITE) PROGRAM

Youth aging out of foster care often face housing instability, unemployment, and lack of support. The Los Angeles Urban League's IGNITE Program creates a bridge to opportunity—ensuring no young person is left behind.

The Los Angeles Urban League now provides workforce training, job placement, and life skills development for foster youth ages 16–24.

We equip participants with the tools and confidence to successfully transition into the workforce and independent adulthood. Our goal is to close opportunity gaps for foster youth by delivering real-world training, career opportunities, and essential life skills that build long-term self-sufficiency.

- Bridge the gap between foster care and adulthood by providing practical, hands-on workforce training.
- Offer personalized job placement support to ensure long-term career success.
- Develop essential life skills to foster confidence, resilience, and independence.

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LA Navigate Together

Access and Mobility Matter

The lack of reliable transportation is a major barrier to employment, training access, healthcare, and education in underserved Los Angeles neighborhoods—disproportionately impacting low-income, elderly, and disabled residents. **The Los Angeles Urban League is working with partners to create innovative, community-based transportation solutions that address these inequities and expand access to opportunity.**

Program Description

LA Navigate Together provides free or low-cost transportation services to LAUL program participants. Services include rides to job interviews, training sites, health appointments, and essential errands. Participants may also receive support navigating public transit or applying for subsidized fare programs.

Length of Program

Ongoing support based on program enrollment (3–12 months typical use)

Cultural Relevance & Language Access

All transportation scheduling services are provided with bilingual staff (English/Spanish). Drivers receive cultural sensitivity training and transportation is offered to culturally relevant program events and sites.

Participation Requirements

- Enrollment in an LAUL workforce, education, or health program
- Demonstrated transportation barrier
- Scheduling through LAUL transportation coordinator

Expected Outcomes

- Increased access to training, employment, and healthcare
- Reduction in missed appointments and dropouts from programs
- Greater independence and confidence in navigating transit options

Healthcare Workforce

In partnership with UCLA Health, our Medical Assistant Certification program offers trainees the opportunity to become certified Medical Assistants in 12 months and guarantees job placement at one of UCLA's nine hospitals and clinical sites.



Backstage Careers

Backstage provides training and job opportunities for individuals who are interested in working in "Below the Line" jobs: technical crew roles in production for film, tv, and live events.



Career Fairs, Job Recruiting, & Upskilling

Our career fairs and recruiting events connect job seekers with employers and local businesses. We additionally offer resume help, interview prep, networking support, and one-on-one coaching to build skills, set goals, and find lasting careers.

Inspiring Growth, New Skills, and Innovation for Transitional-Age Empowerment (IGNITE) empowers foster youth ages 16–24 with workforce training, job placement, and life skills to support their transition to independence. Through hands-on training, personalized coaching, and essential workshops, we build confidence, resilience, and lasting self-sufficiency.

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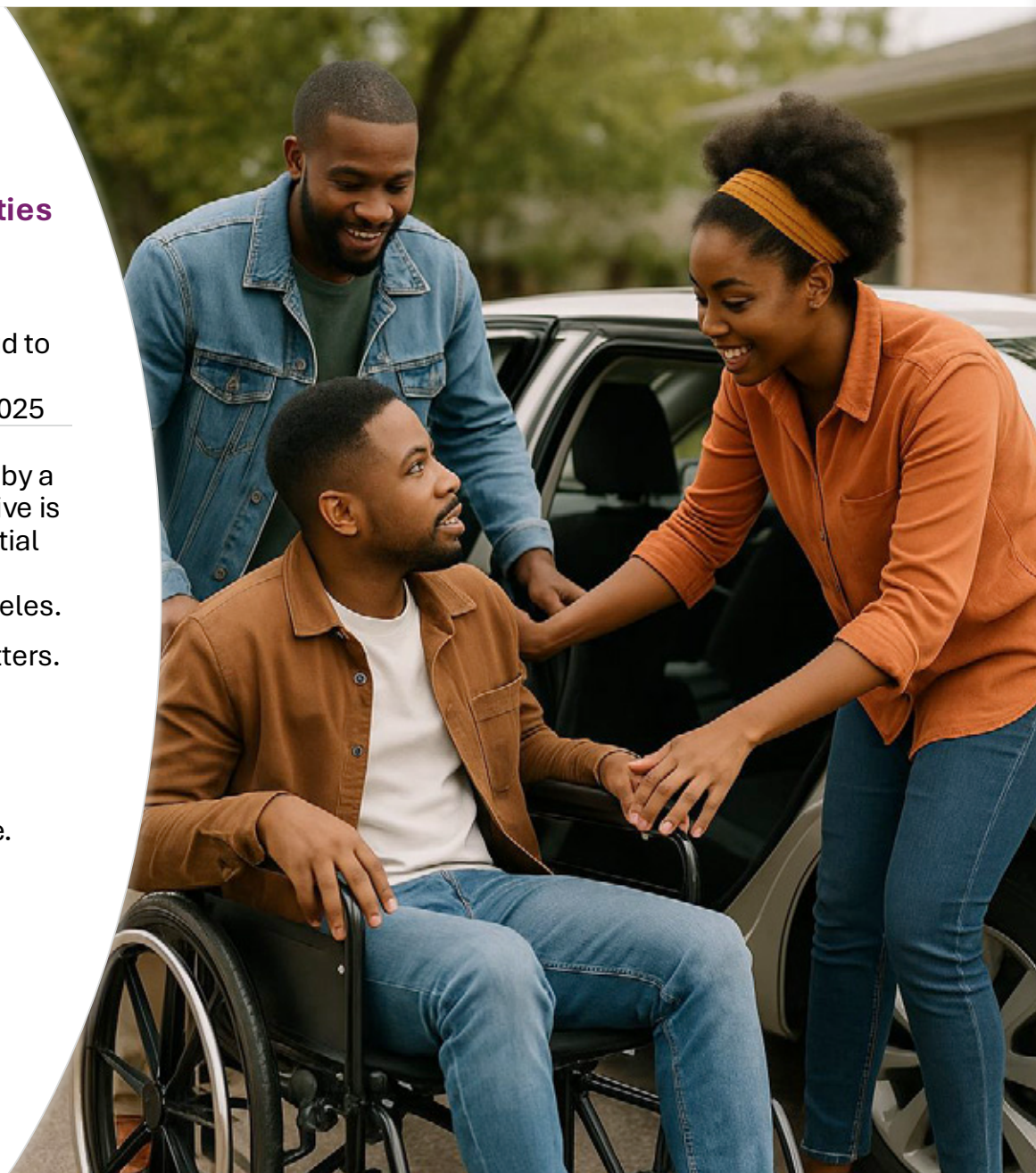
